Eroica Riesling, 2007

We've extolled the excellence of Eroica in previous vintages. This partnership between Chateau Ste. Michelle and Ernst Loosen of the Dr. Loosen wine estate in Mosel, Germany produces the finest Riesling made in America. Named for Beethoven's third symphony, Eroica is a dry Riesling with peach and apricot aromas, broad, lush flavors and a lively acidity.

Erath Winery Pinot Noir, Estate Selection, Dundee Hills, 2008

Erath Winery is located in the Dundee Hills of Oregon's Willamette Valley and constitutes the heart of Oregon's Pinot Noir production. Founded in 1968 by Dick Erath, he was the first of Oregon's pioneering, homegrown winemakers to produce a Pinot Noir in the Dundee Hills, releasing his first vintage in 1972. The Estate Selection is a selection of the best barrels from several estate vineyards in the Dundee Hills, all growing in the volcanic soils important to this area. Well-structured and age worthy, plum and black cherry flavors with hints of cinnamon, anise and sandalwood make this a dynamic example of Willamette Valley Pinot Noir.

Chateau Ste. Michelle Ethos Syrah, 2005

Washington is consistently demonstrating that it has America's best growing areas for the Syrah grape with some wines rivaling those of France's northern Rhone Valley, the epicenter for great wines made from Syrah. Ethos is the pinnacle tier of wine for Chateau Ste. Michelle and the Syrah is sourced from Wahluke Slope, a superb vineyard area of the Columbia Valley, and CSM's Cold Creek Vineyard which was planted in 1973. 100% Syrah aged 20 months in French and American oak barrels, Ethos has rich, jammy blackberry fruit in the style of Hermitage from the northern Rhone. As winemaker Bob Bertheau says, "This is the perfect match for barbeque!"

Antica Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa, 2006

Antica is the Napa Valley property of the Antinori family who has been making wine in Tuscany for 26 generations. Marchese Piero Antinori owns Atlas Peak Vineyard having originally purchased an interest in the property in 1986. The first vintage of Antica from this unique area of Napa Valley was 2004 released in 2007. 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from their estate vineyard in the Atlas Peak district aged 24 months in French oak barrels. This is elegant, rich, pure Cabernet with flavors of currant, blackberry and cherry with a long, smooth finish.
